The camp will focus on learning about the eco-systems in the extensive natural environment around Silkeborg, the largest forested & lake rich area in Denmark. Further the culture and historic part of Silkeborg will be a central part of the camp.

Each participant is expected to be able to walk (approx. 10 km), swim (approx. 200 m) and bicycle (approx. 15 km)

275.00 EUR and personal travel expenses to and from Billund Airport.

Accommodations:

During most of the Exchange, accommodations will be in hostel like rooms (3-4 persons per room) dormitory like accommodations on one excursion. Typical Danish food is provided.
